Every time I am asked to pray, I think of the old fellow who always prayed, “Lord, prop us up on our leanin’ side.” After hearing him pray that prayer many times, someone asked him why he prayed that prayer so fervently.

He answered, “Well sir, you see, it’s like this...I got an old barn out back. It’s been there a long time; it’s withstood a lot of weather; it’s gone through a lot of storms, and it’s stood for many years. It’s still standing. But one day I noticed it was leaning to one side a bit. So I went and got some pine poles and propped it up on its leaning side so it wouldn’t fall. Then I got to thinking about that and how much I was like that old barn...I’ve been around a long time...I’ve withstood a lot of life’s storms. I’ve withstood a lot of bad weather in life, I’ve withstood a lot of hard times, and I’m still standing too. AUGUST 3 is a community picnic to help celebrate the kids and what they have learned about Jesus. All are invited. Please mark your calendars today.




NEXT CHRISTIAN EDUCATION MEETING: August 7 @ 6:30pm @ Newaygo United Methodist Church

Mission Minutes

Our Mission: Support Kids Hope USA.

It's almost time for school to start again! The children have had a hot vacation this summer and they probably are not ready to go back to school. But some of the children are anxious to get back to their friends, new teachers and if they are in Kids Hope, they are probably looking forward to seeing their Kids Hope mentor.

If you are new to our congregation you probably don't know what Kids Hope is all about. It is a program that matches at risk children [in grades K-5] with a mentor who spends time with them for one hour each week at school. They work on anything that the teacher would like them to, or sometimes they spend that time playing games or doing activities that help the child to develop self-esteem, and sportsmanship. They develop a close relationship because usually they are matched with each other when the child is in Kindergarten or first grade and they stay together until the child completes fifth grade. Many of the children stay in touch with their mentors even after they graduate.

Our church has participated in this program for many years and we have a Kids Hope Director (Sherry Graham) who sets the program up each year, matches the children with an adult volunteer, trains the adult for the program and then advises and monitors the program. She does an excellent job of communicating with the schools, the families and the Kids Hope Organization. This program does have some expense involved to run it. Sherry receives a modest salary, there are a couple of parties during the year, and there are some expenses for materials, games, etc. So, this month, the rest of us can get involved by supporting this program and the children in our community. We are the only church in Newaygo who is participating in this program. Can we count on you?


