#### WHAT IS YOUR MISSION STATEMENT?

The nerves may have settled, but I seem to have found many different ways to keep myself distracted enough to avoid jumping into the knowledge of the church. I ask them, and I am going to ask you, to think about and create your own mission statement that you can use to describe your Christian goals. For example my Christian Mission Statement is, "To be the best Christian that I can be; to help those who need and want my help in finding the love of Jesus Christ, while praying for those who do not."

My goal is to help you all discover your gifts, if you have not yet found them, and to achieve a Christian Mission Statement for yourselves to help you enter into your mission field. I am going to lift up a challenge for all of you, to think about what you want to accomplish as a Disciple of Jesus Christ. Create your own Christian Mission Statement that you can turn to for encouragement to keep moving towards Jesus' ultimate goal for you. Good Luck! I am praying for you all!










# CHRISTmas WALK
